

COVID-19 and Inequality – Factsheet for the Survey "Working from Home"

Survey 1 (Z0)

Survey mode: Online survey

Basic population: Employed persons in Germany who work from home, aged 18 and over, representative of the total working population in terms of age and gender.

Selection of respondents: Online Access Panel from Respondi. Membership and participation is voluntary and follows a double opt-in registration process. The panel is actively managed centrally by a professional panel team. In a scoring and control process, the panel is subject to permanent quality control. In the recruitment process via opinion portals, intrinsic motivations are at the forefront. This counteracts a distortion of the sample with regard to the professionalisation of the participants. Respondi is a member of the DGOF (https://www.dgof.de/) and is committed to the ICC/ESOMAR Code (https://www.esomar.org/uploads/public/knowledge-and-standards/codes-and-guidelines/ICCESOMAR_Code_German_.pdf).

Selection probabilities (quotas) for age and gender were determined on the basis of data on the labour force from 2018 from the Federal Statistical Office.

Duration of the survey: 9:02 min (mean value)

Field time: 30.03.2020 - 31.03.2020

Survey 2 (Z1-Z8)

Survey mode: Daily online survey over 8 working days

Selection of respondents: Respondi's Online Access Panel. Study participants* who have already taken part in Z0 were interviewed in the diary study over eight working days.

Data collection: Sosci Survey GmbH

Number of respondents: between 544 and 350 participants

Number of variables: 37 items

Duration of the survey: 2:00 - 2:70 minutes per day (average value)

Field time: 31.03.2020 - 09.04.2020

Survey mode: Online survey

Selection of respondents: Respondi's Online Access Panel. Study participants* who have already participated in Z0 were interviewed again.

Number of variables: 88 items

Duration of the survey: 8:48 minutes (mean value)

Field time: 15.05.2020 - 19.05.2020
